In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, acknowledge and accept that: Horse sports are a dangerous and recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY or DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.

I knowingly freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of The Equestrian Federation of Australia and/or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I voluntarily PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK and assume sole responsibility for ant injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sports activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associate with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this event.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organise or official can results in the CANCELLATION of my participation in the event and my immediate removed from my horse NO MATTER where that may occur. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding during the event and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times whilst riding and rake sole responsibility for my actions.

COVID-19 DECLARATION

Social distancing (1.5m) must be maintained in all areas.

1. No spectators. Essential support personnel only.

2. Persons from restricted areas may not attend or participate.

3. There must be at least 4m clearance between parked floats and vehicles, including portable yards or other equipment associated with the float/vehicle.

- 4. Alternating yards or stables must remain vacant.
- 5. Temperature checks may be undertaken at entry.

6. An attendee's register including name, mobile phone number and time arrived at the venue must be recorded for every person in attendance. Please use the QR code provided at the front gate.

- 7. Persons who are sick or unwell or displaying any sign of sickness must not attend.
- 8. Equipment must be cleaned after use. No sharing of equipment.
- 9. The COVIDSafe app should be downloaded and active.
- 10. Campsites must be separated by a minimum distance of 4m.
- 11. There must be no more than 100 people in any marshalling area, event officials not to be included in the count.

Stables must be mucked out when exhibitors leave. If stables are left dirty, then an account for \$50 will be sent to the exhibitor.
