Rules & conditions of entry

1. Competitors must be experienced and accomplished riders with appropriately trained horses.

2. A rider may compete on more than one horse as long as no competitor is riding the same horse during the competition at any level.

3. Competitors may enter more than one horse but must enter all horses at the same level of competiton, if entries are exceedingly high a restricon may apply. Each additonal horse will be charged full entry fee.

4. Riders competing in the junior secon must be a minimum of 10 years old on the day and not more than 16 years at the start of the competiton.

5. Competors choosing to enter the encouragement secon are not eligible for the Open event & vice versa. Entries in this secon will be at the discretion of the committee.

6. High Point Registered Stock Horse Awards – horses must be nominated at the me of entry. Horses' full registrasion details must be supplied with entry. Horse and rider must both be current financial members of the ASHS on the day of competiton.

7. The expected dress code must be worn for the enre program and will be comprised of:

• Collared shirt with long sleeves (Jacket and e for dry pa)er oponal)

• Approved safety helmet and footwear must be worn for all events.

• Moleskins, jeans or jodhpurs will be accepted.

8. Any horse considered to be acting in a dangerous manner will be warned by the committee in the first instance and then disqualified if it continues to act in a dangerous manner.

9. Stallions must be ridden and handled by and adult (over 18 Years of age) and double ed at all mes when not being ridden.

10. Snaffle bits only to be used – no curb chains.

11. Horse must wear a bit, no bosals or halters or bitless bridles will be allowed.

12. No head checks, e downs, marngales, running reins, nose bands or riding whips will be allowed.

13. The same saddle must be used for all secons of the event, leg protecon for horses and spurs at the rider's discreon.

14. Competors must complete the program as set by the commi)ee.

15. No alcohol to be consumed whilst competing or prior to the completion of the event.

16. No unrestrained dogs allowed.

17. All competitors enter at their own risk with no responsibility accepted by the organising committee for riders, livestock or property.

18. All decisions made by the judge are final.

19. In the event of a protest, it must be made in writing to the Show Secretary and lodged withing 15 minutes of completion of the event. Such complaints to be accompanied by a fee of \$50 which will be forfeited if the protest is deemed frivolous.

20. Entries will only be taken via email by the closing date. No late entries or entries on the day will be
