Ribbons 1st-4th in each event. Rug for the winner in each section

Competition details will be placed on showground FB page and website closer to the event.

Rules & conditions of entry

1. Competitors must be experienced and accomplished riders with appropriately trained horses.
2. A rider may compete on more than one horse as long as no competitor is riding the same horse during the competition at any level.
3. Competitors may enter more than one horse but must enter all horses at the same level of competition, if entries are exceedingly high a restriction may apply. Each additional horse will be charged full entry fee.
4. Riders competing in the junior section must be a minimum of 10 years old on the day and not more than 16 years at the start of the competition.
5. Competitors choosing to enter the encouragement section are not eligible for the Open event & vice versa. Entries in this section will be at the discretion of the committee.
6. High Point Registered Stock Horse Awards – horses must be nominated at the time of entry. Horses' full registration details must be supplied with entry. Horse and rider must both be current financial members of the ASHS on the day of competition.
7. The expected dress code must be worn for the entire program and will be comprised of:
 - Collared shirt with long sleeves (Jacket and e for dry paper optional)
 - Approved safety helmet and footwear must be worn for all events.
 - Moleskins, jeans or jodhpurs will be accepted.
8. Any horse considered to be acting in a dangerous manner will be warned by the committee in the first instance and then disqualified if it continues to act in a dangerous manner.
9. Stallions must be ridden and handled by an adult (over 18 Years of age) and double ended at all times when not being ridden.
10. Snaffle bits only to be used – no curb chains.
11. Horse must wear a bit, no bosals or halters or bitless bridles will be allowed.
12. No head checks, eye downs, martingales, running reins, nose bands or riding whips will be allowed.
13. The same saddle must be used for all sections of the event, leg protection for horses and spurs at the rider's discretion.
14. Competitors must complete the program as set by the committee.
15. No alcohol to be consumed whilst competing or prior to the completion of the event.
16. No unrestrained dogs allowed.
17. All competitors enter at their own risk with no responsibility accepted by the organising committee for riders, livestock or property.
18. All decisions made by the judge are final.
19. In the event of a protest, it must be made in writing to the Show Secretary and lodged within 15 minutes of completion of the event. Such complaints to be accompanied by a fee of \$50 which will be forfeited if the protest is deemed frivolous.
20. Entries will only be taken via email by the closing date. No late entries or entries on the day will be accepted.

Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, acknowledge and accept that: Horse sports are a dangerous and recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY or DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.

I knowingly freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of The Equestrian Federation of Australia and/or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I voluntarily PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sports activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this event.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the CANCELLATION of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse NO MATTER where that may occur. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding during the event and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times whilst riding and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue The Equestrian Federation of Australia and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damages to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

Effect of this Document

I have had sufficient opportunity to read this release of liability and assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement of any kind.

I understand that my signature to this document constitutes a complete and unconditional release of all liability of the Releasees, to the greatest extent allowed by law in the event of me and/or the children under my care, suffering injury or death.
